LYALL BAY BOWLING CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

The following Code of Conduct applies to all Lyall Bay Bowling Club members and persons participating/connected to Lyall Bay Bowling Club activities. Its purpose is to encourage fair, ethical treatment of all persons under the umbrella of the Lyall Bay Bowling Club.

- Respects the rights, dignity and worth of others;
- Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings;
- Be professional in, and accept responsibility for, your actions;
- Operate within the Constitution;
- Refrain from any form of abuse towards others;
- Refrain from any form of harassment towards others;
- Refrain from any form of discrimination towards others;
- Refrain from any form of victimization towards others;
- Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.

Players' responsibilities:

- Display high standards in your language, manner, punctuality, preparation and presentation;
- Display control, courtesy, respect, dignity, and professionalism to all involved in the sphere of the sport – including opponents, coaches, officials, administrators, and spectators;
- Always use the appropriate rules and guidelines to resolve a dispute;
- Conduct yourself in a sportsman-like manner and respect fellow bowlers;
- Refrain from possessing and consuming prohibited substances while within Lyall Bay Bowling Club premises.

Social Members responsibilities:

- Display high standards in your language, manner, punctuality, preparation and presentation;
- Conduct yourself in a respectful manner towards all other members of the Lyall Bay Bowling Club;
- Always use the appropriate rules and guidelines to resolve a dispute;
- Refrain from possessing and consuming prohibited substances while within Lyall Bay Bowling Club premises.

Breaches of the Code of Conduct:

Misconduct involves contravention of the above obligations. Serious misconduct involves serious and/or repeated contravention of the above obligations.

If established, misconduct may lead to a reprimand and warning. Serious misconduct, if established, will usually lead to summary dismissal, that is, dismissal without notice.

Serious misconduct is behaviour, which undermines the contractual relationship

Disciplinary procedures:

Formal disciplinary action is not taken lightly.

Any breach of the Code of Conduct will be dealt with by the Executive Committee who will decide whether the matter will be passed to the Discipline Committee.

The Discipline Committee is comprised of 3 members of the Lyall Bay Bowling Club that has been previously decided by the Executive Committee.

The Disciplinary Committee will deliver their decision to the Executive Committee confidentially.

The Executive may or may not decide to pass the decision of the Disciplinary Committee.
